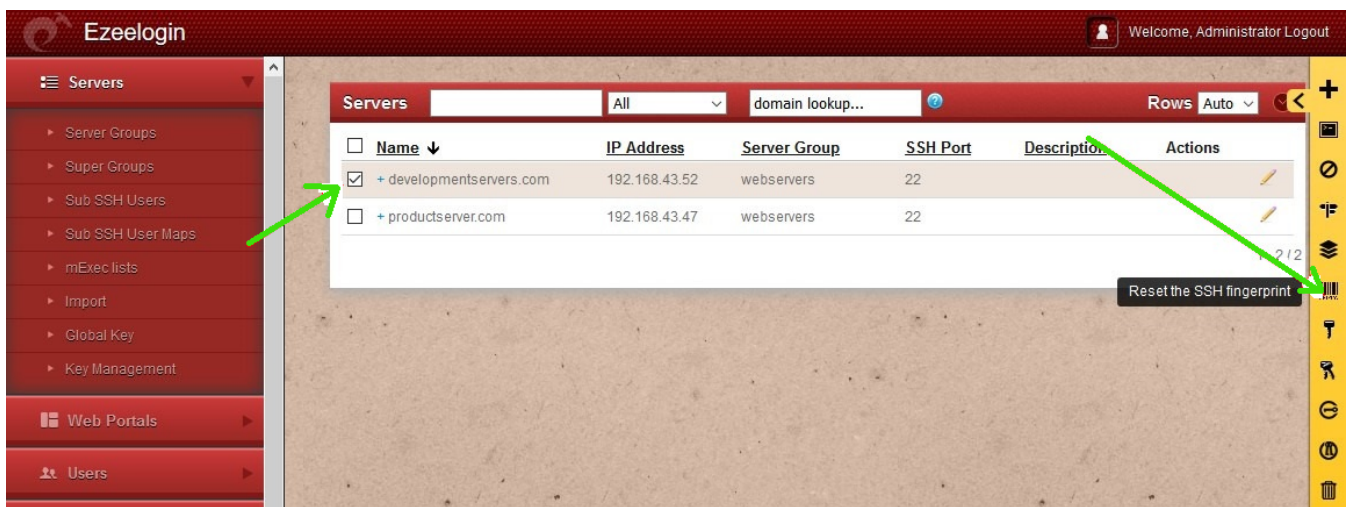
## Steps to re-add a reinstalled server

**Overview:** This article outlines the steps to re-add a reinstalled server. First, select the reinstalled remote server and reset the SSH fingerprint. After resetting, update the new password in the Server -> Edit server section.

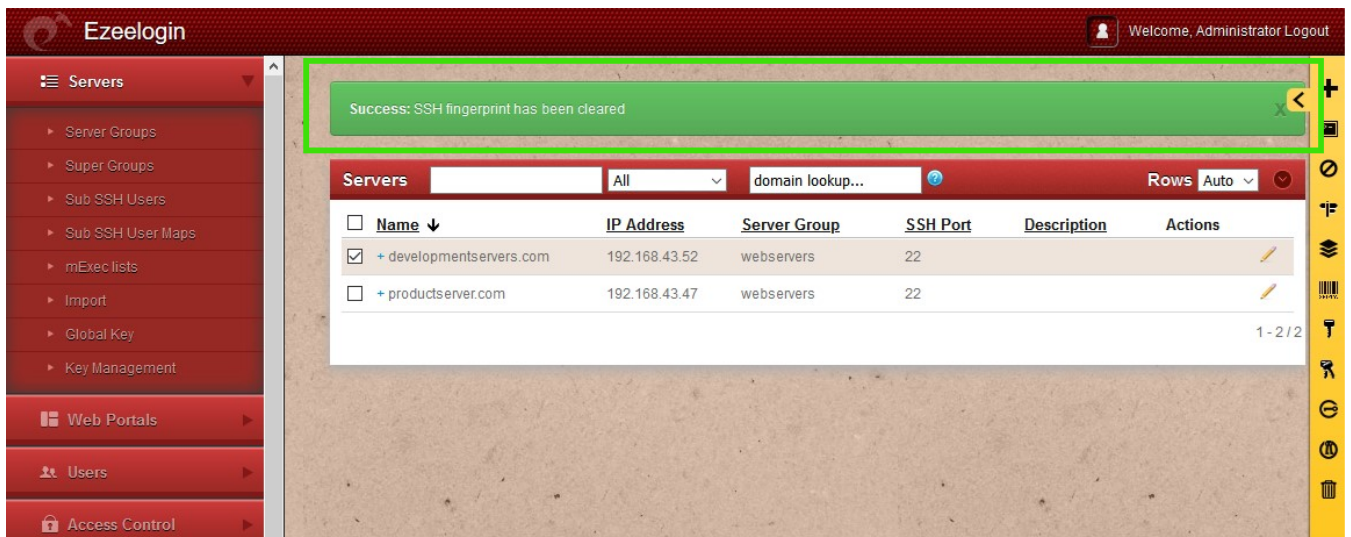
**Step 1.** Select the reinstalled remote server and Click
