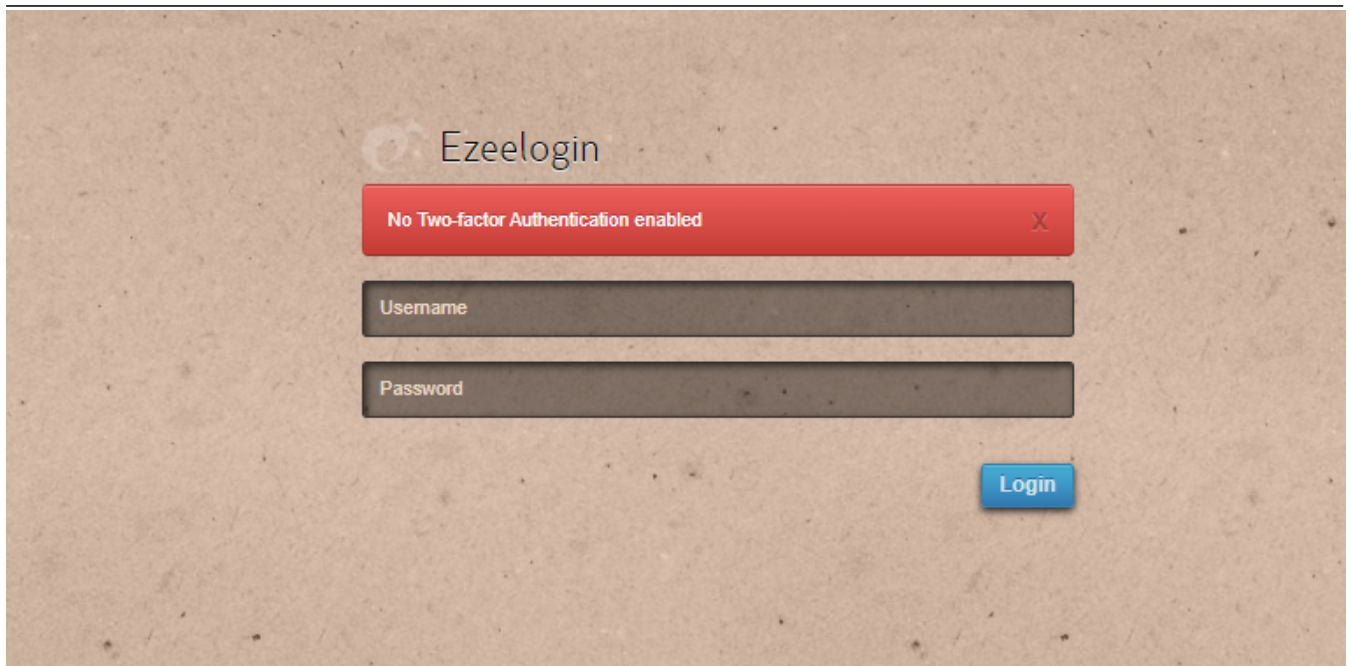

No Two-factor Authentication enabled



This error happens when we enforce Two-Factor authentication without enabling any of the Two-Factor authentications. Run the following command to disable Force Two Factor Authentication. You should re-enable it from the Ezeelogin GUI as follows.

```
root@jumpserver:~# php /usr/local/ezlogin/ez_queryrunner.php  
"update prefix_settings SET value = 0 WHERE name =  
'two_factor_auth' "
```

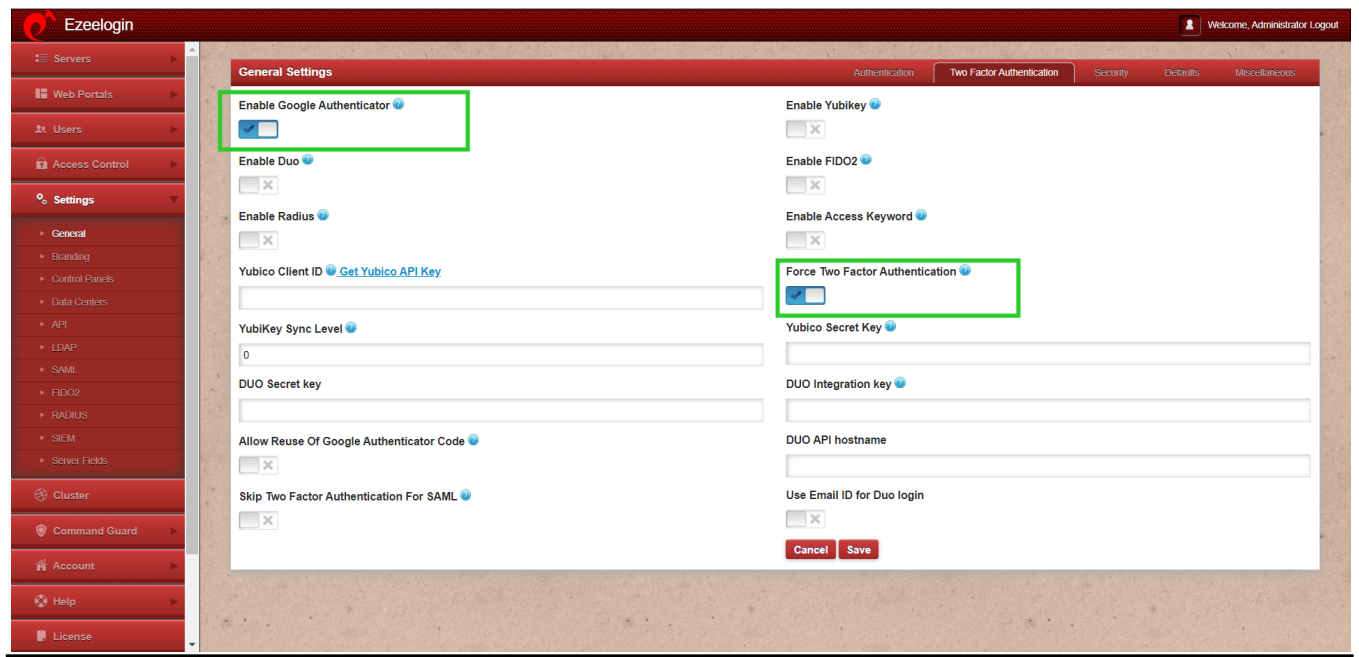
Or

```
root@jumpserver:~# php  
/usr/local/ezlogin/ez_queryrunner.php "update  
prefix_usergroups SET force_tfa = 'N' "
```

You should re-enable the **Force Two-Factor Authentication** and **Two-factor Authentication**

which you have used before
