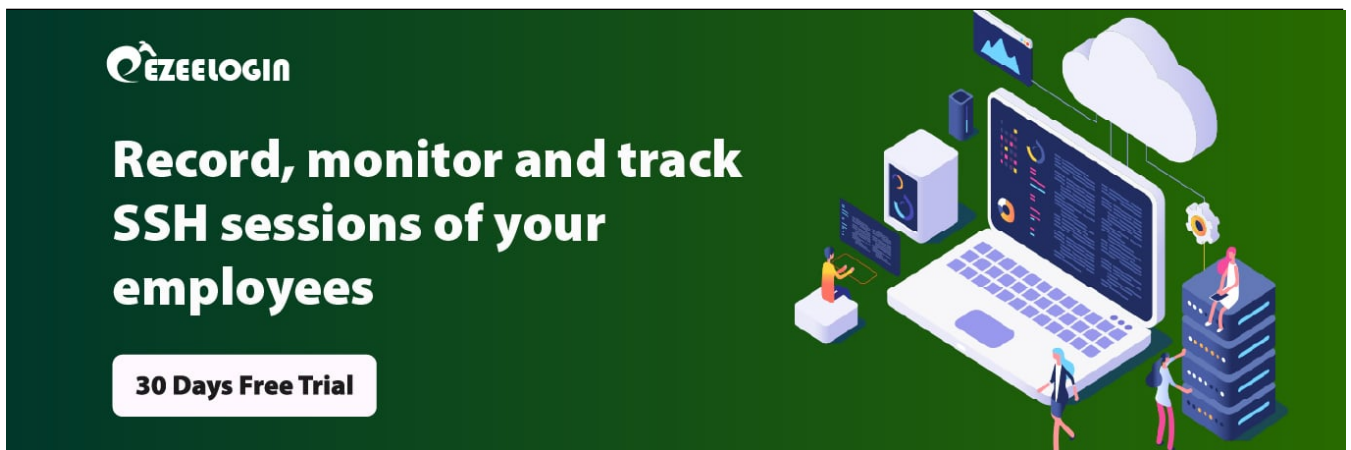

How to solve "channel 0: open failed: administratively prohibited: open failed" error got while trying to SSH?

Overview: This article helps gateway users to resolve the error "**channel 0: open failed: administratively prohibited: open failed**" encountered while trying to SSH.



```
ssh -J bastion_host_server remote_host_server
```

```
channel 0: open failed: administratively prohibited: open failed
```

```
stdio forwarding failed
```

```
kex_exchange_identification: Connection closed by remote host
```

The above error occurred because **AllowTcpForwarding** is set to "No" in the `/etc/ssh/sshd_config` file of the Ezeelogin gateway server for security reasons. This setting is recommended for enhanced security.

```
#$ /etc/ssh/sshd_config
```

```
AllowTcpForwarding no
```
