## How to resolve the issue of F1-F4 keys not working in ezsh when using PuTTY?

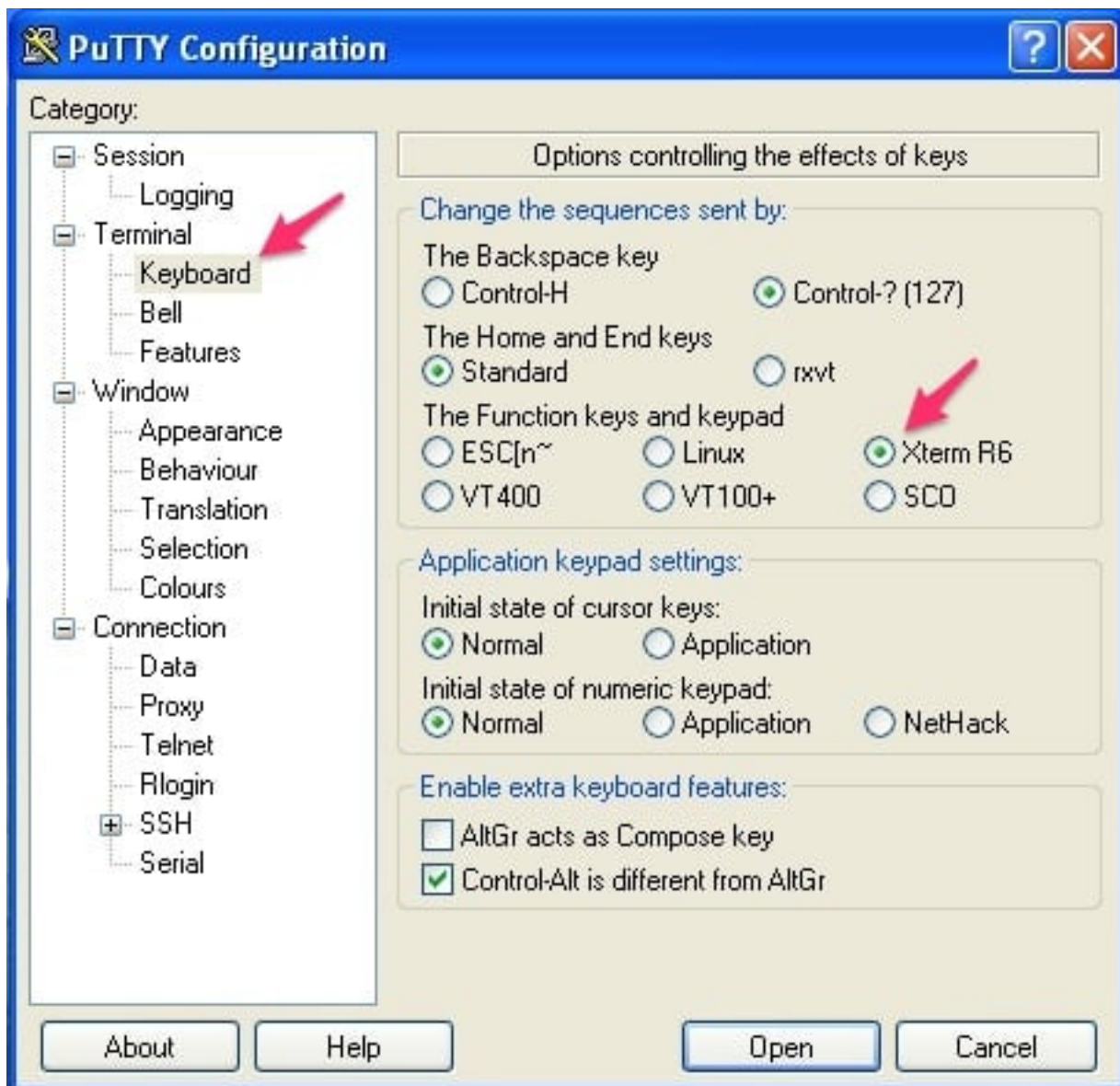

**Step 1:** To fix the issue with the F1-F4 keys while using PuTTY, open the PuTTY configuration

window, navigate to **Terminal** -> **Keyboard**, and change the "Function keys and keypad" setting to "Xterm R6".
