


# Force a password change for a Ezeelogin User

## Forcing a password change for a gateway user on re-login

After enabling the Password change option; while re-login into that user, it will ask the user to change the password before login.

The admin user can force a user to change his password on the next login or an on re-login under **Users > Edit-user > Force password Change**
