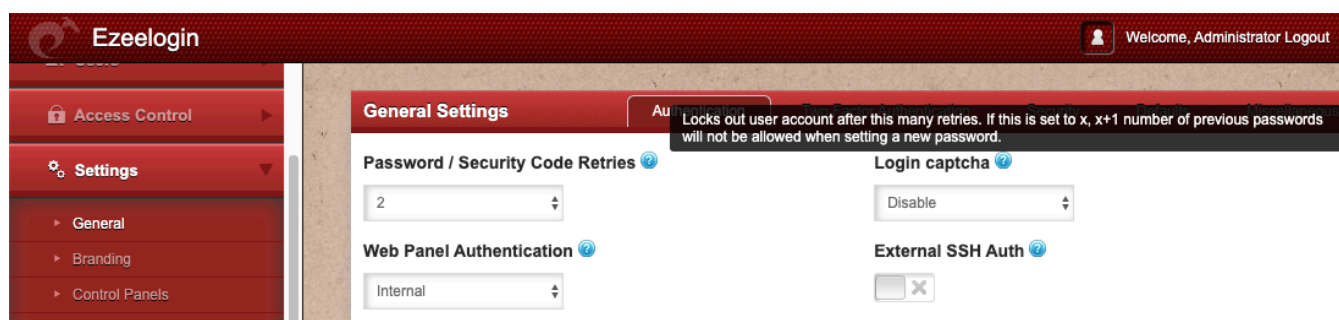


# How many previous passwords can a Ezeelogin gateway user use?

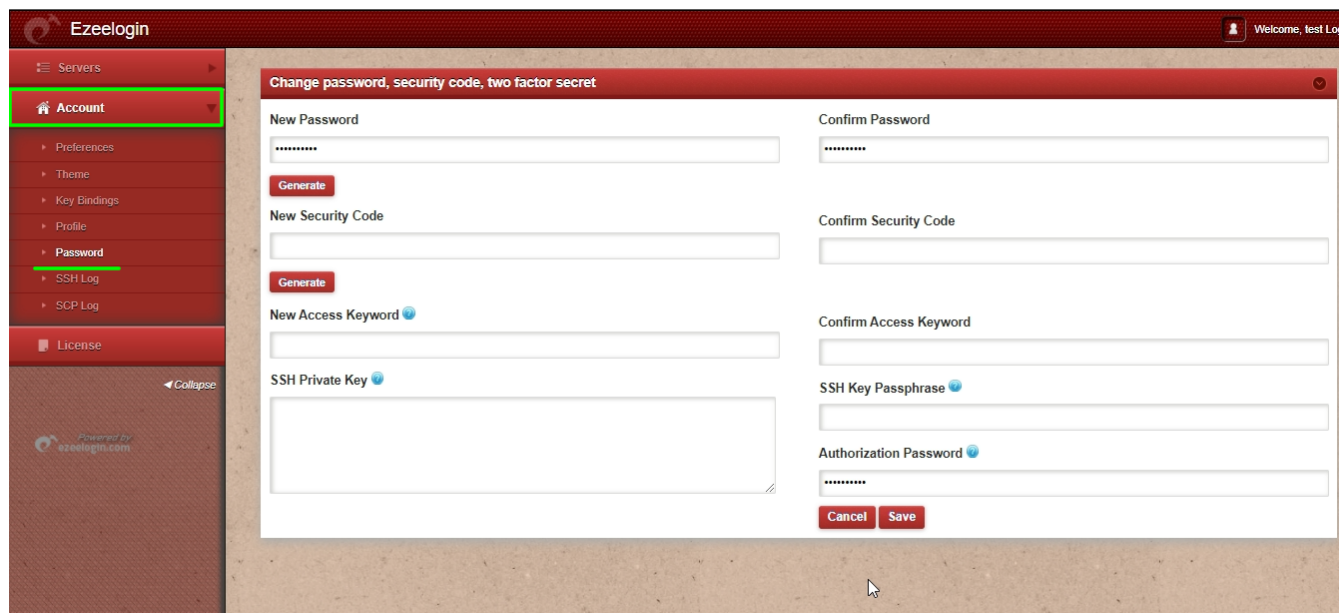
## How many previous passwords can a gateway user use?

Preventing the use of previous password is an important security compliance requirement. This can be set under Settings->General-Authentication-> Password/Security Code Retries. If the retries is set to X, then X+1 number of previous passwords will not be allowed when setting a new password.



In above image, the retries is set to '2' (x), hence the last '3' (x+1) passwords of the user cannot be reused.

User can change their password in **Accounts -> Password**.



User will get the below error when they reuse the same password.

**"Error: You should not reuse a previous password"**
