How to Enable/Disable Two Factor Authentication (2FA) on Ezeelogin Jump Server?

The ssh interface and the GUI of Gateway Server (Ezeelogin Jump Server) are now fortified with multi-factor authentication mechanisms such as Google Authenticator, Yubikey, and DUO Security to ensure that access to your Linux containers is bulletproof.

Note: The QR code generation feature is currently affected by the deprecation of the Google Image Charts API, which ceased operation on March 14, 2024. To address this, kindly [update](#) to Ezeelogin version 7.37.5
