## How to access Ezeelogin backend shell(ezsh)?

There are two options to access Ezeelogin backend.

**1. You can access the SSH backend using any regular ssh clients such as Putty on Windows, Terminal on Mac, or console in Linux.**



**Example:**



Enter password and security code / 2fa when prompted.

ssh ezadmin@192.168.56.226 X + v

Enter Google Authenticator code:

ssh ezadmin@192.168.56.226 x + v
