

## CHANGE MAPPED SUBSSH GROUP

For instance, currently, the Sub SSH user Martin is under User Group Admin\_Servers.




SERVERS (Admin\_Servers) (group) [Normal / ] Start typing string to locate. ESC: Clear search, F1/+: Help, F4/!: Exit.

To change the user group of mapped sub ssh user.

• Click under Server section -> Sub SSH User Maps -> Edit -> Change Group of Sub SSH user.
