or

2.Click "**Fn + F12**" to access the console of the GUI.

If encounter an error **ERR_CERT_AUTHORITY_INVALID** while attempting to perform the edit action in the Ezeelogin GUI, try the scenarios mentioned below to resolve the error.

- Open the Ezconf file and **append " csp_enable = no "**

OR

- This issue is occurring because the SSL certificate is not valid. **Use a valid SSL certificate** to access the Ezeelogin GUI.
