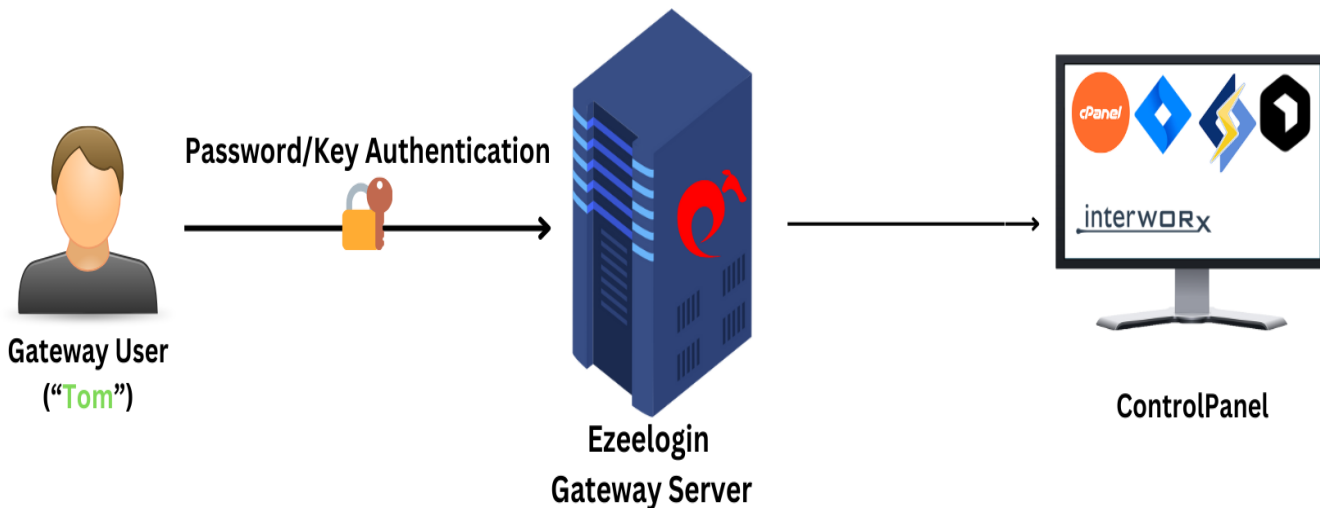

How do I grant access to users in the control panel?

Overview: This article describes the steps to grant control panel access to user "Tom" in Gateway server by using the Access Control settings.

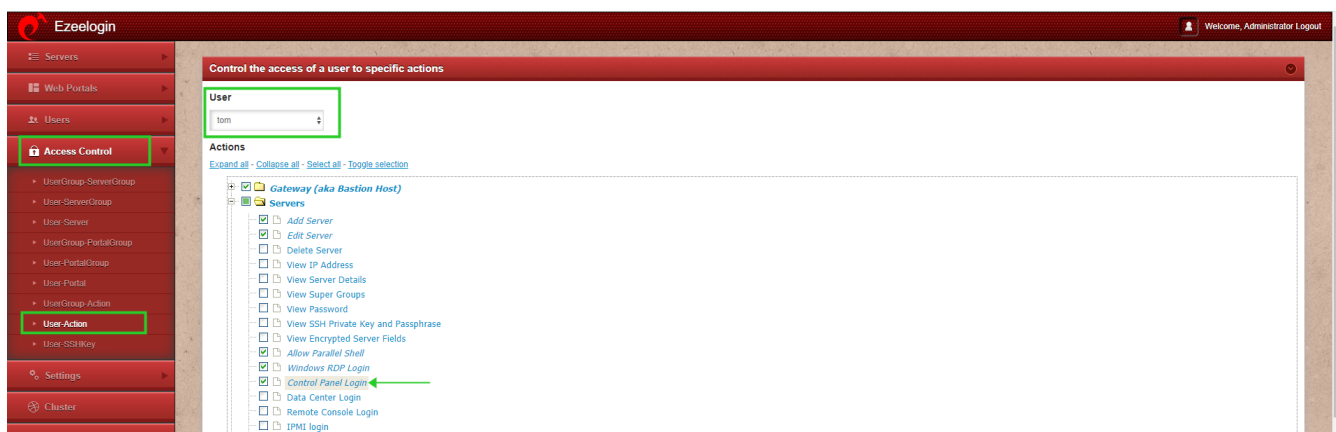
Follow the steps to grant access to the control panel for user "Tom".

Step 1: Log into Gateway server and grant access to the control panel.

Log in to the Gateway Web Interface with a super admin("ezadminxxx") or admin privilege user.

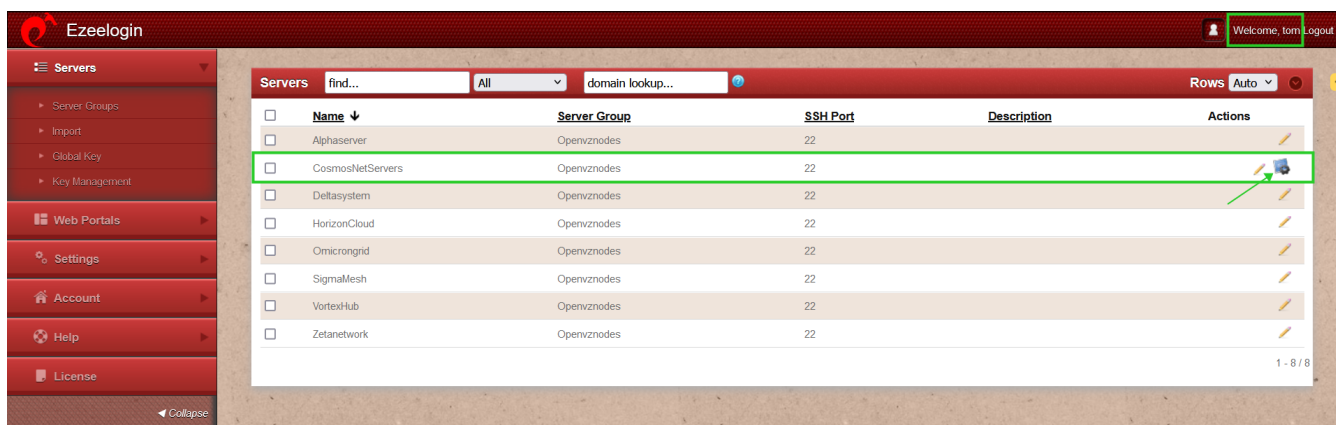
You can use the [access control](#) to grant control panel access to the gateway users.

Navigate to **Access Control > User Action > Servers > Select the particular user to whom you need to grant access to the control panel > and Enable Control Panel Login.**



Step 2: Login as user "tom" and check.

Login As User "Tom" and check; the user would have granted permission to the control panel as follows:



This way, you can ensure user "Tom" has the necessary control panel access by configuring it through the Access Control settings and verifying the changes.
